

Its privileged location offers direct access to the main tourist, cultural and commercial points, making it the ideal place for both business travelers and those interested in exploring the city's rich history.


With excellent public transportation connections and nearby parking, it is the perfect starting point for exploring the historic charms of Cordoba on foot.


# Courtyard

The Patio del Naranjo is more than just a space; it is a symbol of tradition, hospitality, and the charm that defines our hotel.












